## USTI NAD LABEM



Our Volunteer Centre in Ustí nad Labem, Czech Republic was established in 1999 and since its foundation it has been focused on working with volunteers in various areas such as sports, culture, hospitals or mentoring programs for children.

## CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

- **WORKING RESIDENCE**

Volunteers will be lodged in local dormitories.

- **FOOD**

Volunteers will receive a monthly food allowance.

- **POCKET MONEY**

At the beginning of each month, the volunteer receives pocket money of 150€.

- **TRANSPORTS**

Bus pass is provided.

## LENGTH OF THE MISSION

The mission will start in **September 2023** and will last **8 months**.

We need your help with educating the public about our volunteer projects, administrative day-to-day activities in the office, developing our online presence and helping run our social media accounts and accompanying our staff on various missions and initiatives.

**ACTIVITIES** : To help run the centre and you will be encouraged to carry out activities of your own interest, such your own miniproject, which you are required to carry out under the guidelines of the ESC.

**Youth MENTORING** : Two government-accredited mentoring programs exist for children and young people. You'll regularly meet children aged 7 to 15 who need special educational or social support.

**SPORT** : You can choose your favourite sports and teach the local children and youth. We provide all necessary equipment and give you great freedom in the way you want to choose to organise your volunteering activities.

**CULTURE** : You can organise your own events, meet professionals, and cooperate with the local community cinema, museum, library, or art galleries. You can take part in organising charity events such as concerts, clothes and plant swaps and many more.

**SOCIAL** : You will take part in helping the local refugee centre as well as aiding our Ukranian colleagues with activities in their community centre.
